
ABSENT: Mayor Jerrod Jones

- A. CALL TO ORDER @ 6:00 PM
- B. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND INVOCATION
- C. PUBLIC COMMENTS, RECOGNITIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS-
Sonny Hubbard of Piney Woods Sanitation expressed interest in bidding for garbage services when the current contract is up in 2022.

- E. DEPARTMENT REPORTS
1 - 4) Motion by Housler and second by Reeder to approve the Department Reports for Police, Fire, Municipal Court and Engineering. Motion carries.

- G. CONSENT AGENDA
1-5) Motion by Glick and second by Housler to approve the Consent Agenda items. Motion carries.
- H. REGULAR AGENDA
OLD BUSINESS-
 - 1) Motion by Glick and second by Reeder to approve the Post Event Analysis Report for Cody NesSmith Memorial Team Roping and Ranch Rodeo. Motion carries.
 - 2) Motion by Glick and second by Reese to reject all quotes for roof repairs to the Fire, Court/ Police, and Library buildings. The projects will be rebid at a later date. Motion carries.NEW BUSINESS
 - 1) Motion by Housler and second by Glick to approve the Investment Report for period ending June 30, 2021. Motion carries.
 - 2) Motion by Glick and second by Reese to approve the Ordinance Prohibiting Drilling and Mining or the Reopening of any Abandoned Well or Mine in any Public Park located within the city limits of the City of Buffalo, Texas. Motion carries.
 - 3) Motion by Glick and second by Reeder to approve MRB Group for Engineering Services for the Texas Parks and Wildlife Grant. Motion carries.

- 4) Motion by Housler and second by Reeder to table the Renewal of Contract for Express Wisp LLC until more information can be acquired. Motion carries.
- 5) Motion by Housler and second by Reeder to table the Post Event Analysis Report for Buffalo Cornhole 306 until all receipts are received and a representative could be present. Motion carries.
- I. CLOSED SESSION- The council went into Closed Session at 7:30 pm pursuant to Section 551.074 regarding Personnel Matters.
 - 1) Council discussed the Appointment, Employment, Evaluation, Reassignment, Duties, Discipline or Dismissal of Water/ Sewer Utility Supervisor.
- J. RECONVENE INTO REGULAR SESSION- The council reconvened at 7:52 pm and took the following action:
 - 1) Motion by Glick and second by Reese to accept the resignation of Michael Hahn as the Water/ Sewer Utility Supervisor. Motion carries.
- K. COUNCIL COMMENTS- Housler advised that the council should watch the construction closely in the downtown area due to issues. Glick, Reese, and Housler agreed that closer attention to details should have been done to prevent the current issues from occurring. Glick commented that there were several areas around town that need some cleaning up and the large amounts of brush that had yet to be picked up by maintenance. Reese offered to help direct the maintenance crew with approval from the mayor due to the recent resignation of the Water/ Sewer Utility Supervisor. Ryder advised that budget workshops were needed to finalize the upcoming budget for the new fiscal year and suggested the dates of August 9th and 16th at 6:00 pm. She also passes along information from Mayor Jones regarding fire hydrant testing that is scheduled to take place in August.
