ABSENT: Martin Housler


VISITORS: None


1) Attorney Jerry Nowlin gave an update on the status of the Sidewalk Project (DRP) and related grant. He advised that a letter was mailed on behalf of the City to the contractor and bond company regarding delays in completion.


2) The council discussed budgets for Water Works, Motel Occupancy Tax, and General Fund. It was suggested that the current loan on the Buffalo Administrative Building be paid off soon to save on interests fees. The council also voiced strong opinions on the state of the streets and much needed repairs. Options on how those repairs could be paid for were discussed and will be addressed at a future regular meeting.

3) Mayor Jones asked the council what duties and responsibilities they believed a Water Works Maintenance Supervisor would have. He also asked for a base salary suggestion so that the office could work up a formal job description posting to advertise.
