

NEW BUSINESS
  - 1) Motion by Glick and second by Housler to approve the *Proposed* Ad Valorem Tax Rate of \$0.359271 per \$100 appraised value. Glick- Aye, Housler- Aye, Ryder- Aye, and Reese- Aye. Motion carries.
  - 2) Motion by Housler and second by Ryder to set the Public Hearing on the Fiscal Year 2022 – 23 *Proposed* Budget on September 19, 2022, at 6:00 PM. Motion carries.
  - 3) Motion by Ryder and second by Reece to set the Public Hearing on the 2022 *Proposed* Ad Valorem Tax Rate of \$0.359271 per \$100 in appraised value on September 19, 2022, at 6:00 PM. Motion carries.

- F. RECONVENE INTO REGULAR SESSION
- G. COUNCIL COMMENTS – Councilmember Glick asked about the timeline of the Downtown Revitalization Project (DRP), Phase II, and the status of current litigation involving a former police officer. Mayor Jones responded with updates on both. Housler asked a follow up question regarding lighting on the DRP, Phase I, project. Glick also asked about the surveyors on Davis Street and N. Buffalo Avenue. Mayor Jones responded that they are surveying for our engineers that are handling the grant funded sidewalk grant.
- H. MAYOR COMMENTS- Mayor Jones gave an update on the status of Downtown Revitalization Project (DRP), Phase II. He also stated the Harriman Park renovation has begun and that equipment should be brought in to start ground work this week. He advised the council about a water leak on S. Buffalo Avenue at the auto parts store. He also mentioned that Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) is installing street lights at the exit/entrance ramps on Donie Road/Highway 164. Finally, Mayor Jones stated that the sale of the Civic Center would need to take place after the November General Election so that the Leon County Elections office has ample time to locate a new voting location for that precinct.
